

A WORD FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR


Hello,

We continue to pilot new programming models designed to improve outcomes for children and families and support the well-being of staff. Our lifelong journey to embedding equity in the fabric of the organization is moving forward with deep work on developing policies to better support all families and staff. Along this journey we are working to delight in everyday moments, celebrate our successes, and find deeper joy and purpose in our work!



All of this beautiful work is happening in the midst of an early childhood system which is deeply challenged. Head Start and child care systems have historically been built on the backs of low wage labor, particularly of women of color. These systems have never received adequate funding to pay staff livable wages and now are bracing for funding cuts at the state and federal levels. This is a challenging moment to stand in, and my greatest hope is that a new, healthier system will eventually emerge from the ashes of the old.

As we move forward into 2025, we will continue to support and care for all the members of our Reach Dane community and work to create the future our children, families, and staff deserve. Many thanks to all of our supporters who share this dream and we look forward to our continued connections!

Reach Dane changes the lives of underserved children and families through education and supportive services.





ENVIRONMENTS

This year, we invested in updated playgrounds and made key facility improvements to ensure our spaces are safe, welcoming, and developmentally supportive. We've also shifted our approach to sourcing classroom materials, prioritizing partnerships with local businesses to strengthen community ties and promote sustainability.



Our HR Equity Collective is actively developing a compassionate leave policy that better reflects the diverse needs of our staff. This work is rooted in a commitment to creating policies that are inclusive, culturally responsive, and aligned with our values of care and equity.



TRUST

We introduced the Integrated Support Specialist role to provide consistent, site-based support by blending expertise in education, family services, and mental health. Each site now has a primary support person, fostering stronger relationships and improving the quality of teaching practices. This effort is helping to build a culture of trust and shared accountability across the agency.




RELATIONSHIPS

The implementation and ongoing study of the Sprouts Classroom have demonstrated positive outcomes for both children and staff. Additionally, our Connection and Reflection Circles offer a dedicated space for staff to come together, deepen relationships, and strengthen our sense of community



COMMUNICATION

To strengthen agency-wide communication, we launched an internal communications team focused on improving transparency, collaboration, and connection. One of our key accomplishments is the launch of the Reach Forward newsletter, which shares internal updates, celebrates staff accomplishments, and highlights collective efforts across departments and sites. This newsletter serves as a central place for staff to stay informed and engaged with the work happening throughout the agency.

We prioritize access and inclusion, ensuring every child, regardless of income, background, or ability receives the tools and support they need to thrive.




Community-Rooted Care





Reach Dane's Satellite Family Child Care System supports home-based educators throughout Wisconsin in offering high-quality, child-centered care aligned with Satellite's accreditation standards. Focused on six core areas: **relationships**, **environment**, **programming**, **development**, **professionalism**, and **health/safety**. Participants receive individualized coaching, resources, training, and opportunities for mentorship, networking, and family referrals.
