Children as the Co-Constructors of Their Own Learning: Emergent Curriculum in Family Child Care

This course will introduce *Emergent Curriculum* as a method of guiding curriculum practices in family child care. Participants will learn how to use observations of children to plan learning experiences that support (1) holistic child development and (2) the diverse needs of a mixed-age group. We will dive into the foundational principles of Emergent Curriculum through exploring the role of the family, the educator, and the environment. Join this interactive session to gain new ideas for how to follow the interests, temperaments, and cues of children when planning playful child-directed experiences.
