 - Ideas were gathered for potential providers to be featured at the Parade of Homes, paying providers a stipend, and inviting community members to highlight quality family child care. Information was also shared about participation in the SEQUAL (Supportive Environmental Quality Underlying Adult Learning) survey for family child care providers through WECA.

2. 2020 Satellite Budget:

Satellite Advisory Committee members reviewed the 2019 Budget/Actual and 2020 Budget document.

2020 Revenue line items include:

- City of Madison grant
- Provider fees
- Dream Up
- UW Partnership
- Other (conference fees)
- 2020 Expense line items include:
- Salary and wages

- Fringe benefits
- Contractual and consultation
- Occupancy
- Transportation
- Supplies and food
- Other (insurance, professional development, copying/printing, etc.)

Additional revenue for 2020 includes the Dream Up funds used for shared services. Discussion about shared services revenue in the future, and moving funds from staff training/technical assistance to provider/peer training.

3. Recruiting Satellite parents to the committee:

Satellite continues to look for parents to join the Satellite Advisory Committee. This is a requirement in the system standards and with the City of Madison. Flyers were shared at the annual meeting in January, and information was included in the Satellite newsletters. Additional information will again be sent out to providers to continue to recruit parents for the committee.

4. Other Items:

Discussion about the new Satellite consultant, staffing arrangements and provider/consultant assignments. The Satellite staff will be having a retreat on March 25th to work on provider assignments. Following that meeting, providers will be notified about consultant assignments that may have changed.

Updates were shared about TB testing, which is currently required every 2 years through Satellite, along with health exams. Licensing rules require an initial TB test and physical exam, and no subsequent exams are needed. Satellite will get clarification from the City of Madison on this, and will report out to providers how often TB tests and health exams will be required going forward.
