
## Opportunities to work with your Satellite accreditation consultant.





You and your accreditation consultant are continuing to align your program with the Satellite Accreditation Standards. Together, you determine the pace of your work towards accreditation:

- What is your preferred timeline for achieving accreditation?
- How often are you available to meet?
- How much work will you do outside of your meetings to make changes aligning your program with the standards?
- How much support would you like in addition to this focus on the standards? Your consultant is available to talk
  through difficult situations in your program, to help you develop skills or find resources to meet children's needs, and
  more.

Answers to the questions above determine how many visits, phone calls, and Zoom meetings you may have with your accreditation consultant. At a minimum, you meet one time each quarter, including a minimum of two informal observations of your work with children each year.
