## **ASQ 3 and ASQSE Reference Guide**

## ASQ3

- ASQ 3 –Complete at Enrollment
- Completion Process:
  - Teacher with Parent
  - 2. CBFS with Parent complete (give copy to teacher to review)
  - 3. Teacher complete
- Follow Up/Referral Process-EHS compliance specialist will send report; CBFS will make sure follow up is completed.
  - 1. Parent on own (send home)
  - 2. CBFS with Parent
  - 3. Teacher (complete and give to CBFS)

## **ASQSE**

- ASQSE- At Enrollment and Fall & Spring
- Completion Process For Enrollment:
  - 1. Teacher with Parent
  - 2. CBFS with Parent complete (give copy to teacher to review)
  - 3. Teacher complete
- Completion Process for Fall & Spring:
  - 1. Parent on own (send home)
  - 2. CBFS with Parent
  - 3. Teacher (complete and give to CBFS)

**Administration:** In center based EHS the receiving teacher will support the *parent* to complete the ASQ-3 and ASQ-SE, if they receiving teacher cannot complete with the parent the CBFS will complete with parent (if this is not able to happen, the teacher will then complete the ASQ-3 and ASQSE within the 45day screen date). CBFS's will then score the screeners. The ASQ-3 and ASQ-SE are then turned into the Site Director. Ideally, take a minute to score while present with the parent and discuss the outcome and any next steps.

**Follow Up:** The ASQ Re-Screen Master Report will be completed monthly by the EHS Compliance Specialist and sent to the ITHAD Team, and the CBFS Supervisor in order to support follow-up. In center based the CBFS receives induvial site reports and will make sure the follow up is completed.

When a child scores below cut-off on the **ASQ-3**, the child needs to be re-screened in one month using the screener that is age appropriate. If the child fails a second time, the CBFS/EHS Teacher and Site Director in center based will discuss the best approach in discussing with the caregiver and offering a Birth to Three referral. The plan to continue to monitor the child's progress, and re-screen again may also be decided. The Disability Specialist may be consulted at this time if needed.

When a child falls below cut off on the **ASQ-SE**, the CBFS needs to contact the Infant Mental Consultant assigned to their program via email for next steps. In the email please include:

- \*Name and DOB of child
- \*Areas of concern indicated on tool
- \*Any observations you have regarding concerns and areas of strengths
- \*Parent reaction and perspective when you discussed the score
- \*Family/child circumstances that might be affecting the score
- \*Strengths and concerns observed in the caregiver-child relationship
- \*Plans you already have for supporting the family/child related to the concerns identified

The child needs to be re-screened at the time the child reaches the next age level of the ASQ-SE. The intervals for the ASQ-SE screener are 2, 6, 12, 18, 24, 30 and 36 months.
